Potato Growers Schedule Meet Tuesday Night

Potato growers of Lancaster County, faced by many problems of production and marketing the past season, will get together and discuss some of their problems and try to find a solution Tuesday night next week.

The meeting, scheduled to start at 7:30 in the Farm Bureau Auditorium on the Dillersville Road between the Old Harrisburg Pike and Manheim Pike, will include discussions by members of the Pennsylvania State University and others.

"Soils and Soil Fertility" is the topic to be discussed by James Eakin, extension agronomist, Pennsylvania State University. J. O. Pepper, entomologist, Pennsylvania State, will tell of "Potato Insects and Their Control." Turning to another phase, Dr. R. S. Kirby plant disease specialist of Pennsylvania State University, has as his topic "Potato Diseases and Their Control."

Another subject scheduled is "Potato Diversion Program," to be presented by a representative of the Pennsylvania Potato Growers Cooperative.

"Bring your neighboring potato growers along and get the facts on a better program for the coming year," advises Harry S. Sloat, associate county agent.
