Conestoga Twp. Newest Joining Bang's Campaign

Conestoga Township this week signed up herd members 100 per cent for initial area brucellosis tests, making the 14th township in Lancaster County to join the fight against undulant fever.

Signing up Conestoga Township carries out a forecast made only a week earlier, at Dairy Day by Dr H. A. Milo, director of the Pennsylvania Bureau of Animal Industry, who said Lancaster County is far ahead in this program.

Earl Groff, R1 Strasburg, county chairman of the Bang's Disease eradication program, called the meeting, and Walter Warfel, R6 Lancaster, reported 23 of the 25 owners of herds in the Township had signed.

Six Advantages Listed
Dr P V Clarkson, Lancaster veterinarian for the BAI, listed six advantages from area brucellosis testing

1, We must have clean herds to sell milk;
2, Tested herds stay clean, only 23 per cent infection is reported in 1955 in the 32 counties then certified clean,

3, In an area test, everyone must test;

4, No untested animals are allowed to enter a tested area, eliminating a big source of infection;

5, The milk-ring test is used only in area testing, and

6, The state and federal governments pay all costs of area testing, both blood and milking.

Already 1,565 herds in Lancaster County are under test in the individual herd plan, with 611 certified clean, 870 negative, 79 show some infection, and five still under plan B.

County Agent Max M. Smith urged that further efforts be put forth to sign up all the remaining 27 townships to make sure Lancaster County is not the last County in the state to be certified.
