## Champ Angus in Brandywine From Robinwood

Continuing a winning streak that carried him through the State Angus Show, Eastern National and the Pennsylvania Farm Show, Royal Bandoher RWN, an entry of Robinwood Farms, Camp Hill, Pa., Saturday won the 9th Annual Spring Show of the Brandywine Angus Association at the Guernsey Sales Pavilion, Lancaster.

Heading the females as grand champion was an entry of Echo Falls Farm, New Hope, Pa., Runnymede Buxom Maid 243rd,

which later topped the sale at \$3,100.

Judging the show was Dale Fletcher, owner of Dal' Bairn Farms in Pine Plains, N. Y.

Mr. Fletcher's comments followed closely those of Dr. William L. Henning, himself a breeder of Angus, and state secretary of agriculture: "I still believe the beef cattle business in Pennsylvania is good, we need more of them"

Also on hand to assist in the showing was Tom King, from the beef department of the Pennsylvania State University Robinwood Farms' Royal Bandoher RWN stood third in class at the 1955 State Angus Show in Reading, fifth in the 1956 Farm Show at Harrisburg, and ninth in the Eastern National. He was royally bred, a son of Globe Hill Royal Bandoher out of Escort's Miss Burgess F. P. His owners reported he had gained consistently 2.3 lbs daily without the aid of a nurse cow or highly concentrated feed.

### Reserve Bull to Hosler

Reserve champion bull, which later sold into Lancaster County to Mark Hosler, R3 Manheim, was the June 4, 1953 Eileenmere of Ash Grove, consigned by Ash Grove Farms, New Hope, Pa. He was a son of Kinlochmere 20th out of Witch 2nd of Shadow Isle.

Grand champion female was a Buxom Maid Miss Burgess that was two years old in early January, Runnymede Buxom Maid 243rd, entered by Echo Hills Farm, Inc., New Hope, Pa.

Reserve champion female was Brookside Barbara 5th, shown by Brookside Farm, Whitmarsh, Pa. Short-legged, smooth, she was sired by Bardoliermere of Den-Mor, out of Brookside Barbara 2nd. She was a show calf in the Brookside string.

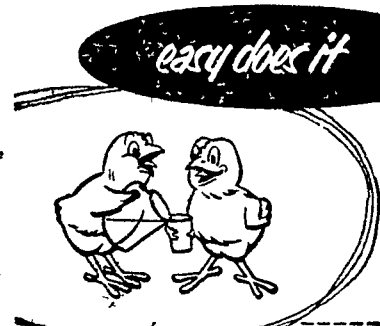
