One-half pound sausage meat Two teaspoons grated onion One-fourth cup bread crumbs One-half teaspoon salt

One-eighth teaspoon pepper 12-18 large tresh mushrooms Mix sausage, onion, crumbs, salt and pepper Wash mushrooms, dry and remove stems Chop stems finely and stir into

sausage mixture. Form into balls and place in mushroom caps Arrange mushrooms in baking dish and bake at 350 degrees F 20 minutes, basting once. Four servings.
