## Iowa State Advised For New Laboratory

WASHINGTON — (USDA) — Secretary of Agriculture Ezra Taft Benson has approved the recommendation of the site committee for the location of the proposed USDA laboratory for work on animal disease at Iowa State College, Ames, Iowa, subject to completion of satisfactory arrangements locally

Announcement of the decision was made Tuesday by Acting Secretary of Agriculture Truman D. Morse. Congress has under consideration an estimate for an appropriation for construction of the new facilities.

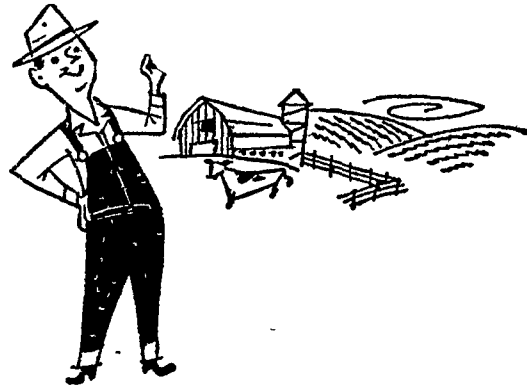


Aaron S. Glick here starts outside finishing work on his barn — raised this weekend by some 90 friends and neighbors — while others continue their work
