Mixed breeders 20-28c without clearing.

Lancaster Poultry Exchange (Rohrerstown, Pa) (Sales Report, sale 161, Tuesday, July 10, 1956) — Prices moved a trifle lower July 10 with the largest Tuesday receipts recorded by

the Lancaster Poultry Exchange. Twenty-two lots totaling 56,700 broilers sold in a range of 23 to 24½, averaging 23.82 cents, a decline of but 16 of a cent from Thursday.

Listed were 25 lots, 72,600 birds, offered were 23 lots, 60,100 birds. One lot of 600 Leghorn fowl sold for 17¼ cents and one lot totaling 250 capettes brought 28½.

Listed for Friday are approximately 150,000 birds.

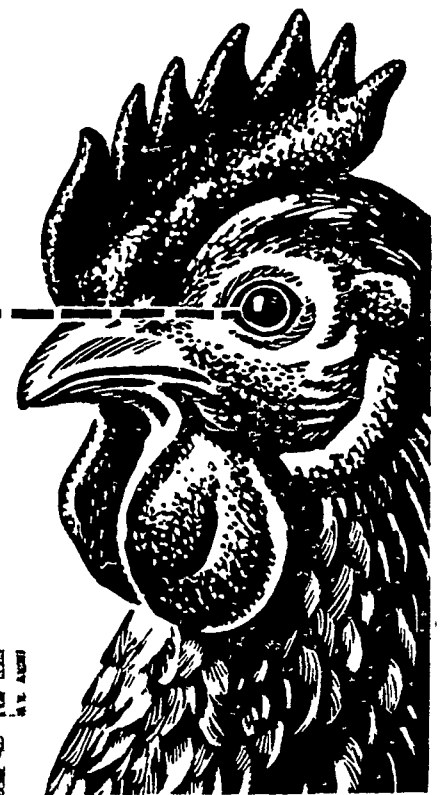
