## Broiler Prices Go Below 20c; Average 19.20

Lancaster Poultry Exchange (Rohrerstown, Pa.) (Sales Report, Sale 171, Tuesday, Aug. 14, 1956) — Averaging 19.20, broiler prices at the Lancaster Poultry Exchange Tuesday this week declined from the Thursday average, with seven lots, 19,050 birds listed and offered, five lots, 7,650 sold, with four lots of broilers, 7,300, selling from 19 to 19 1/2 cents, averaging 19.20, and one lot, 350 capettes, bringing 22 1/4.

There was no auction on the corresponding day a year ago. For Thursday, Aug. 16, approximately 100,000 were listed. Listings for Tuesday's Sale, Aug. 21, may be made up to 4:30 p.m. Friday, Aug. 21.

Fresh cross pullets 28-29 cents. Large white rock caponettes 27-29 cents, few lots higher without clearing, carried over reds 25 cents with bulk unsold. Few lots cross roasters 18 cents. Cross fryers 23-25 cents, silver cross straight cockerels 25 cents, white rocks 18-23 cents without clearing, vantress reds 23-26 cents. Few lots caponnetted light type broilers 18 cents. Turkeys unsettled. Demand light for light supplies. White Holland mixed breeders 20-25 cents, No. 2 quality 16-18 cents.
