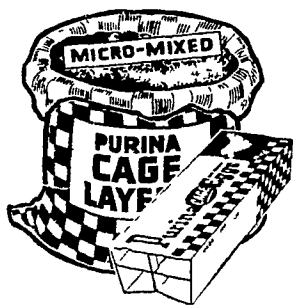

It's a busy season in Lancaster County on is silhouetted against the horizon at the top level of a three-story barn near Kinzer. (Lancaster Farming Staff Photo).

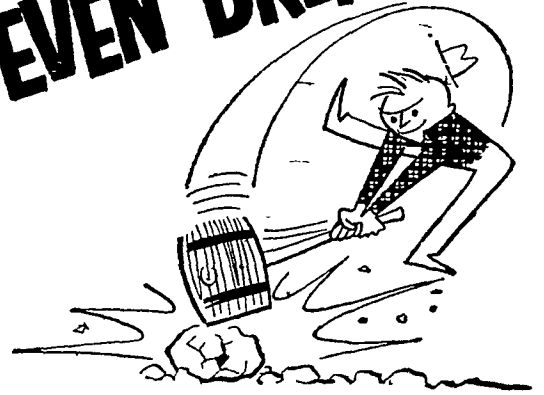

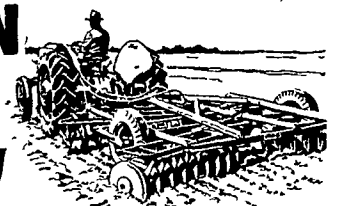
