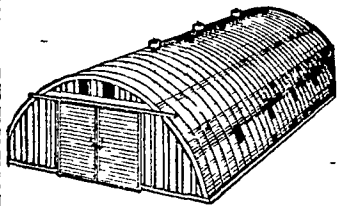

Tomatoes by the Trailerload



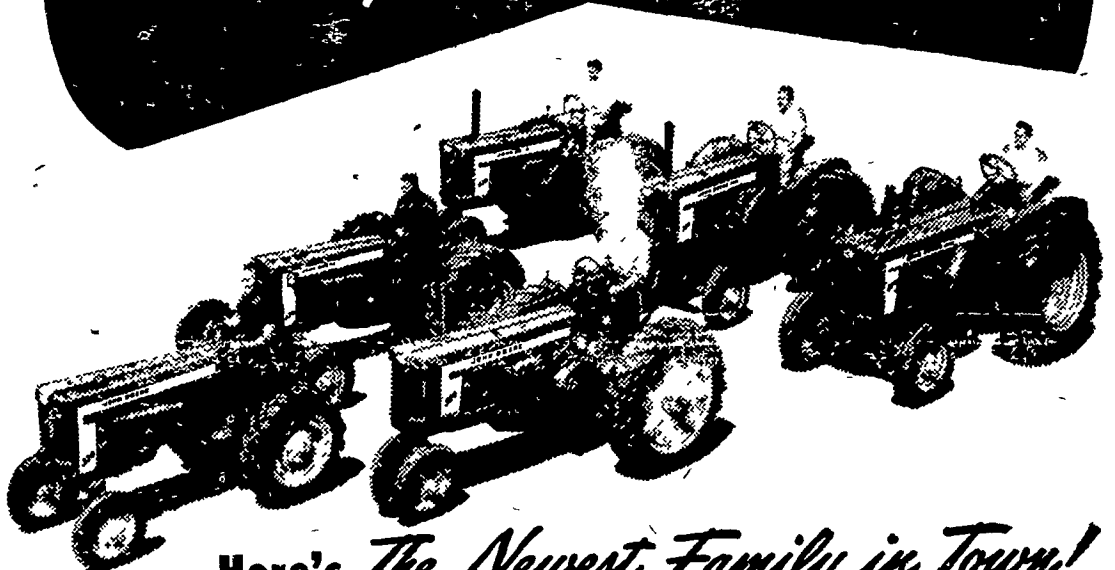
