# **West Lampeter Livestock Show for** 1956 Especially Heavy in Entries

Another community fair in 1956 Lancaster County history is complete, with the Friday night Groff; 5, Verna Landis. sale of 29 FFA club swine in auction at the West Lampeter Community Fair.

Prices ranged from \$2250 to \$17 cwt, with the top going to Donald Welk, R1 Strasburg, on four fattening pigs that brought him a total of \$186.65. Purchaser was Kunzler & Co., Lancaster packing firm, who raised the \$17 70 winning bid made earlier by Sam Edwards, Willow Street. to pay the young showman the premium.

The reserve champion pen of four, weighing 755 lbs, sold to Ezra Martin, Lancaster, at \$17.00 for Robert McCullough, R1 Strasburg. The champion pen of two pigs, also shown by Donald Welk, went to Mr. Martin for \$17.70 cwt.

Kenneth Young, R1 Mount Joy, Guernsey; John Erb, R2 Manheim, Ayrshire; Marlin Cassel, R1 Manheim, Holstein; and John Hess, R1 Washington Boro, Brown Swiss. Breed associations donated the calves.

Witmer, president of the county association, with the calf from the herd of David Brackbill, R7 Lancaster; Ayrshire, by Lloyd Flory of the County Ayrshire Breeders Association, with calf a registered daughter of an Ayrshire cow in the Milton Brubaker, R1 Lititz herd; Holstein, by Donald Eby, Gordonville, from the Eby herd; Brown Swiss, from Fairacres Farm, Princeton, N. J., by Ray Pickel, representing the association.

Robert Welk, R1 Strasburg, was named champion 4-H Club showman, and Paul Trimble, R1 Quarryville, reserve. Elvin Shelly, R1 Manheim, won the grooming contest, and his brother Richard was second.

Winning the tractor-driving contest was Kenneth Landis, R1 Strasburg; second, Kenneth Garber, R1 Willow Street, and third, James Esbenshade, R1 Strasburg.


