International Dairy Show to Open Saturday

CHICAGO — Youth will be in the spot-light at the International Dairy Show in many contests and events planned for 4-H and F.F.A. boys and girls, and college students, at the 4th annual renewal of the show, Oct. 6 to 13.

It will be held here in the International Amphitheatre — world's largest show building — comprising over 12 acres of exhibit space and an arena seating 8,000, all under one roof.

All events on Monday, Oct. 8, will feature farm youth and their accomplishments, according to officials of the show. The junior classes of all breeds of dairy cattle will be judged that day.

Exhibitors will be 4-H and F.F.A. boys and girls who raise and show purebred dairy animals as Club projects. They will compete for more than \$6,000 in cash prizes and special trophy awards in each of the following breed competitions: Ayrshires, Brown Swisses, Guernseys, Jerseys, Holsteins, and Milking Shorthorns.

Three judging contests — two for agricultural college students and one for 4-H members — are also scheduled on Oct. 8, the management reports. They are

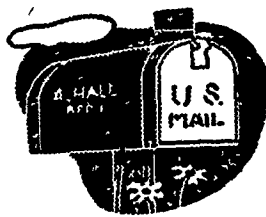
