Q. If a father and stepmother with four children (all of age) have a joint deed, who will receive the property if the father dies first? And who if the stepmother dies first? What is a joint deed? — S. M.

A. Under ordinary circumstances, if the name of the father and his second wife appear on the deed, and the father dies, the second wife will take title to the property. If the second wife dies first, the father will take title. What happens after that depends upon the wording of the deed. They might hold it "jointly", that is, with the right survivorship, or as "tenants in common", that is fractional interest.

This is so important that you should submit your deed to an attorney who can look at the exact wording and very easily explain how you hold title. If the father dies first, an undivided fractional interest might pass to the stepmother's collateral relatives.

Q. I loaned a soldier \$110 three years ago. I have written him asking for it but have had no luck. He was being sent to Korea at the time and needed the money because he wanted to take his car to California. His mother and I were friends and she is the only proof I have. I really could use it, as I am self-supporting and the family knows it but it doesn't mean a thing. Please advise me what to do. — M. R.

A. If the man is still in the military service, a letter to his commanding officer might result in the necessary encouragement for your debtor to remember his personal obligations. Should this fail, you may start suit against him before a magistrate or justice of the peace the next time he is home on leave. Although the soldier could delay the proceedings because of his military service status, you should eventually be successful. Don't wait too long, because there is a six-year statute of limitations in actions of this type.

PETERBOROUGH, N. H. — A registered Guernsey cow, Brian Boru Royal Pearl, owned by John M. Gibson, Drumore, has completed an official production record of 11,920 lbs of milk and 511 lbs of fat, according to the American Guernsey Cattle Club.

This production, made in the AGCC's Herd Improvement Registry is equal to 5500 quarts of high-quality milk.

"Pearl" was a five year-old, and was milked two times daily for 305 days while on test.

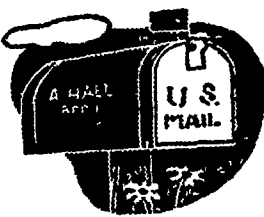
