Broilers Tuesday At Year's Low, Averaging 17.70

Lancaster Poultry Exchange (Rohrerstown, Pa.) (Sales Report, Sale 182, Tuesday, Oct. 9, 1956) — Ranging only from 17.25 to 17.75 cents broiler prices Tuesday stayed around the year's low on offerings of 13 lots, 51,360 birds. Sold were nine lots, 43,160 birds

A year ago — in the corresponding sale Oct. 11, 1955, Sale 92—12 lots of a total 21,490 birds were offered, 11 lots, 21,200 sold in a range of 22 and 22.25 cents.

Listed for Thursday were a record-breaking 233,000 birds, largest listing for any one day, and with Tuesday's sale will bring the Lancaster Poultry Exchange to new records in one week's receipts.

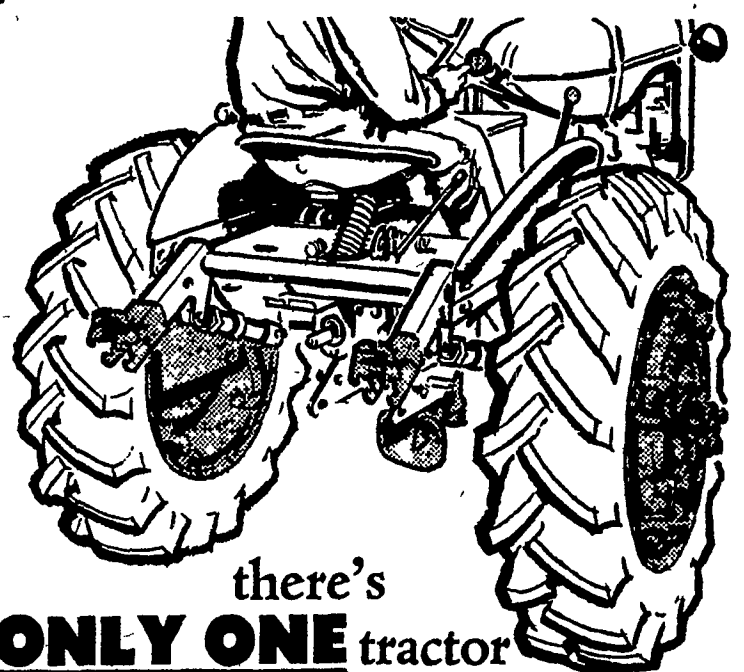
