Because of many conflicting activities, it was voted to change the regular night of Colerain Grange to the third Tuesday of every month.

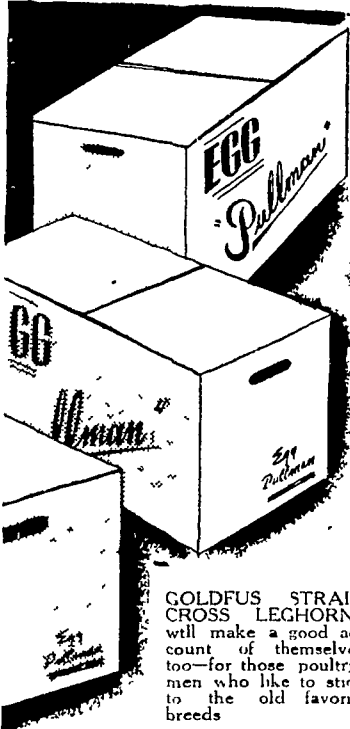
Colerain Grange will meet in regular session on December 18 at Kirkwood Hall.

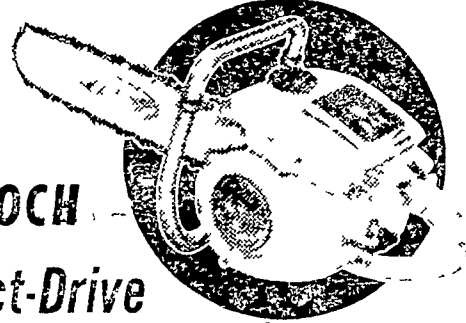

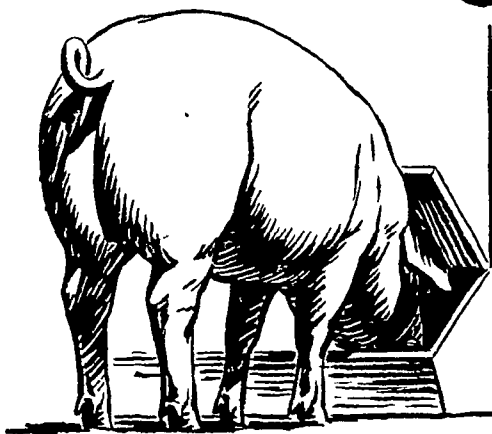

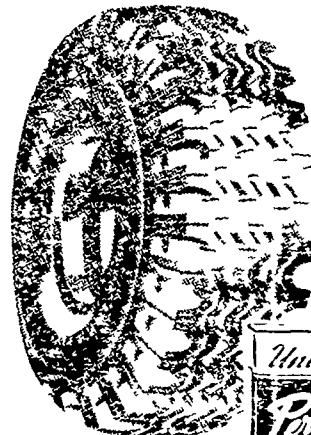
