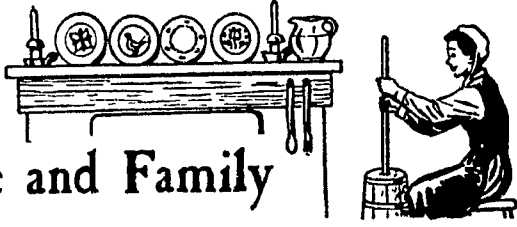

MONTGOMERY PIES

R1 Ephrata

One egg
One cup sugar
One-half cup molasses
One grated lemon
One cup water
Second part:
Two eggs
Two cups sugar

One-half cup butter or lard
One cup thick milk
One tablespoon soda
One tablespoon cream of tartar
Three cups of flour

A few drops of lemon juice in the food chopper will keep figs, raisins and dates from sticking to it while they are being "run" through the chopper.

It's The Law

Q I own a property along a highway which is going to be widened by the State. This will take a big portion of my grass plot. Will I be reimbursed for this since it will make my home much closer to the road?

A Yes, you will be paid damages for the reduced value of your property caused by the highway construction. First you will be asked by your County Commissioners to agree on a price. If agreement is not possible, you may successively present a petition to the local Court of Quarter Sessions, seek the appointment of viewers to ascertain and assess damages, appeal from the award of the viewers to the local Court of Common Pleas where a trial by jury may be had, and a further appeal may be taken to the Supreme Court, if necessary.

Q I would like to inquire as to what is necessary for a person to change his name legally. I was born abroad, of American parents. Would this cause any difficulty? I have all my birth papers in order. Is there any charge for such a proceeding? Is it necessary to hire legal counsel?

A B

A. The legal procedure in Pennsylvania for changing one's name is prescribed by the Act of April 18, 1923, P. L. 75, Section 1, et seq., 54 Purdon's Statutes, Section 1, et seq. Change is accomplished by petitioning the Court of Common Pleas in the county which you reside for such name change, setting forth adequate reasons and documentary proof in support thereof. Such petition is advertised in local newspapers and legal journals, and a hearing is held thereafter by the Court, at which the petitioner introduces testimony in support of his request for change of name. It is probable that the name change procedure could be accomplished without too much difficulty in your case, but it is suggested you consult an attorney who can advise you specifically and inform you of the probable cost.

Q If a man dies without a will, leaving a wife and children, what portion of his estate does his wife receive? What are the exceptions to the percentage of an estate which a wife will receive? Would there be any property which would be given outright to the wife alone?

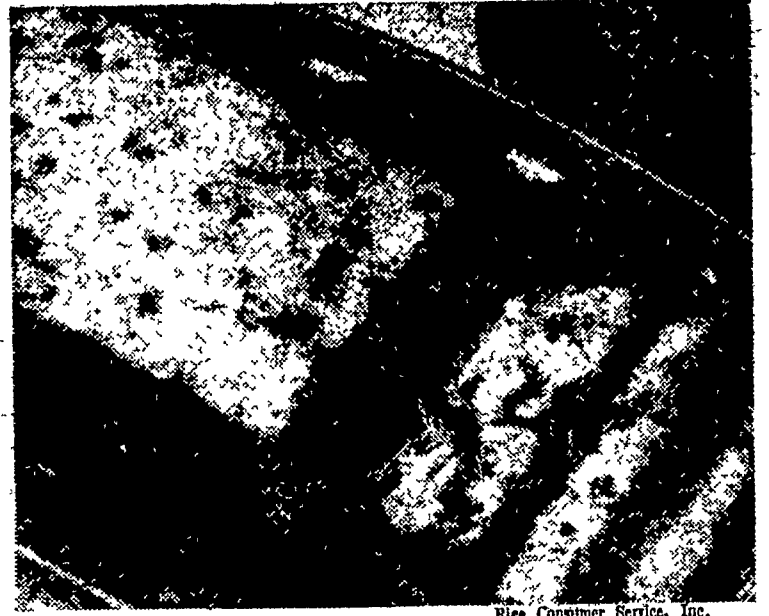

A Assuming the man had more than one child, his wife would receive one-third of his estate, and the children would divide the remaining two-thirds equally. No particular property is given to the wife. Before the estate is divided, the wife would receive \$750 which is excepted from the estate.

TURKEY-PIMIENTO LOAF

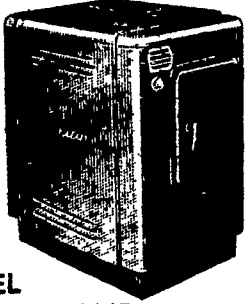
INGREDIENTS:
2/3 cup uncooked white rice
1 1/3 cups water
1 teaspoon salt
3/4 cup milk
3 eggs, beaten
2 cups finely chopped turkey (or chicken)
3 tablespoons finely chopped green pepper
1 tablespoon finely chopped onion
1/2 cup chopped pimiento
1 1/2 teaspoons salt
1/2 teaspoon black pepper
1/4 teaspoon celery salt
1, 10 1/2 oz. can condensed cream of mushroom soup
1 cup milk

METHOD: Put the rice, water and salt in a 2-quart saucepan. Bring to a vigorous boil. Turn the heat down. Cover with a lid and simmer over this low heat 14 minutes. Remove the saucepan from the heat but leave the lid on 10 minutes.

Stir in the 3/4 cup milk, eggs, turkey, green pepper, onion, pimiento, salt, pepper and celery salt. Mix thoroughly. Pour into a heavily greased loaf pan holding at least 5 cups. Place the loaf pan in a pan of hot water. Bake in a pre-heated 350°F oven 1 1/4 hours or until the loaf is firm and a silver knife inserted in the center comes out clean but slightly moist.

Remove the loaf from the pan of hot water. Cut around the edges and down the sides and ends of the loaf pan. Allow the loaf to stand 10 minutes. Place a large plate over the loaf pan and invert. Place the serving platter over the loaf and invert again so the browned top of the loaf will be up. Serve with a sauce made by heating together the 1 cup of milk and the condensed cream of mushroom soup. This recipe makes 8 to 10 generous servings.
