WASHINGTON — (USDA) — Checks totaling \$28,035,256.40 were mailed to the 40 states and 2 territories containing national forest lands as their share of receipts from those forests, the U. S. Department of Agriculture announced today. These checks represent 25 per cent of the total money collected by the Forest Service from national forests between July 1, 1955 and June 30, 1956.

This amount is the largest ever sent to the states and is a 45 per cent increase over the \$19,381,154.57 sent a year ago. It reflects the record receipts from timber sales, grazing permits, and other land uses from national forests in fiscal year 1956.

The size of the check sent each state depended on the receipts collected from the national forests within that state. Some states, therefore, received a substantial increase over last year; others received less.

According to the law the money sent to the states must be used for the benefit of public roads and schools within the counties in which the national forests are located.

Spain Aided by Cured Fat Back Buying in U. S.

WASHINGTON — (USDA) — The U. S. Department of Agriculture today announced issuance of an authorization to Spain to finance the purchase of up to \$800,000 worth of cured fat backs from United States suppliers under Title I of Public Law 480. The authorization was issued in

accordance with a recent agreement with Spain to substitute this amount of fat backs for \$400,000 worth of dry salt bellies and \$400,000 worth of lard previously agreed to.

Authorization No. 17-24 provides for purchase of approximately 1,935 metric tons of cured fat backs.

Specifications applicable to the fat backs are a part of the authorization and may be obtained from the Foreign Trade Programs Division, FAS, U. S. Department of Agriculture, Washington 25, D. C.

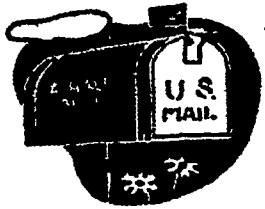
