Show Classes for Hereford Revised As of July 1, 1957

KANSAS CITY, Mo — (Special) — A revision in show classification and order for Hereford breeding cattle, effective July 1, 1957, was voted by the Board of Directors of the American Hereford Association.

The revised classification divided the Senior Calf class into Senior Bulls and Heifers calved between Sept. 1st and Oct. 31st, and Winter Bulls and Heifers calved between Nov 1st and Dec. 31st. All groups have been eliminated except three bulls, two bulls, and the get of sire. The class for Two-Year-Old females has been eliminated.

In the Junior Calf class, the division is

- A. For shows before Jan 1st Calved after Jan. 1st the previous year.
- B. For shows after Jan 1st Calved between Jan 1st and Sept 28th of the previous year.

For shows after Jan 1st, there is included in the classification a special class for the late spring calves which would include those calves dropped after March 1 the previous year. This class would replace the present Summer Calf class.

The Junior and Senior Calf classes are divided the same in the Junior Division breeding show.

In the open and junior steer competition, the Board recommended a division based on age classes — Junior Yearling, Summer Yearling, Senior Calf, and Junior Calf.

Beef Purchase by Spain Authorized Up to \$1,002,400

WASHINGTON — (USDA) — The U. S. Department of Agriculture has announced issuance of an authorization to Spain to finance purchase of up to \$1,002,400 worth of frozen carcass beef from United States suppliers under Title I of Public Law 480. The issuance was under an understanding with Spain to re-authorize amounts remaining from purchase authorizations previously issued.

Authorization No. 17-35 provides for purchase of approximately 4 million pounds of U. S. Utility Grade Carcass beef.

Specifications are as follows: frozen carcass beef in quarters. Class — steer, heifer or cow; Grade — U. S. Utility. Equal number of fore and hind quarters unless contract specifies fore or hinds only. Weight range — fore quarters 115 to 210 pounds, hind quarters 105 to 190 pounds. The beef shall be thoroughly frozen as expeditiously as practicable after chilling, and at a temperature not higher than minus 5 degrees F. and shall comply with requirements specified in Paragraphs 31 and 321 of Federal Specifications for Beef, Fresh, PP-B-221c.

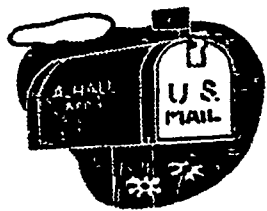
