Smokey Bear International Symbol Now

Smokey, the forest fire preventin' bear, has gone international. the U S Department of Agriculture says A cooperative agreement between the Forest Service and the Canadian Forestry Assn has just been signed which makes Smokey the official forest fire prevention symbol in Canada as well as in the United States

The Association of State Foresters, which works with the Department's Forest Service and The Advertising Council in conducting the Nation's forest fire prevention program, authorized this agreement. Application to have the Smokey Bear symbol copyrighted in Canada has been made to the Canadian Trademark Office In the United States the Smokey symbol is protected by an Act of Congress

Director J. L Van Camp of the Canadian Forestry Association expects the Smokey Bear Program to have as great an appeal in Canada as here. Edward Cliff, Assistant Chief of the Forest Service, in signing the agreement, he thought both the United States and Canada would benefit from combining efforts and concentrating on a single campaign
