

## Broiler Prices Show Slight Rise At First Sale in New Center

LANCASTER, Jan. 24 — (Lancaster Poultry Exchange, sales report 198) — Broiler prices showed a slight rise this week at the first auction held in the new Poultry Exchange building in Lancaster. The number of birds sold dropped to 167,520 from last week's 212,150.

Prices paid were: Broilers, 19 to 20 1/4 cents, average 19.96 cents for 162,850 birds.

Capettes, three lots, 4300 birds averaged 24.92 cents. Capons, one lot of 20 birds, 24 1/2 cents. Pullets, one lot of 350 birds, 23 1/4 cents.

A year ago broiler prices averaged 24.25 cents at the Tuesday auction and 23.01 cents at the Thursday auction. At the two sales, 142,791 birds were sold. There was no sale at the Lan-

## Lancaster Market: Steers Down, Veal Market Active, Steady

LANCASTER, Jan. 31 — CATTLE: Three days 2,850, week ago 3,000. Compared with last Wednesday, slaughter steers and yearlings steady to 50 cents lower with full decline on weights 1,100 lbs. and over. Heifers weak to 50 cents lower, cows fully steady. Bulls unevenly steady to 25 cents lower, instances 50 cents off.

Stockers and feeders slow weak to 50 cents lower. The steer supply included a few lots average choice steers mostly good to low choice. Offerings comprised around 40 per cent stockers and feeders and about 12 per cent cows. About five loads heifers on sale, balance mainly slaughter steers. Bulk choice fed steers 1,100 lbs. and lighter \$20-21.50, choice steers scaling 1,150 lbs. and up \$19.50-21 but very few offered averaged over 1,250 pounds.

A part load 1,060 lb. Choice yearlings \$22. Most good grade steers \$18.50-19.25, standard and low good \$17-18. Several loads good fed heifers \$18, few head around \$19 and load choice \$68 lb. heifers \$20.50. Standard down to \$15. Utility and commercial cows mostly \$11.75-14, canners and cutters \$9.50-12.75, shelly canners down to \$8. Utility and commercial bulls brought \$15-18,

good fed bulls \$18.50-20.50, cutter and low utility \$13.50-14.75.

Bulk medium and good stocker and feeder steers and yearlings 513-998 lbs. \$16-19.50 one load good 875 lb. feeders \$19.75. Common stock steers \$12.50-15. A few lots good and low choice 400-500 lb. stock steer calves \$19-22.

CALVES: 749, week ago 767. Vealers moderately active mostly steady with last Wednesday. Bulk good and choice vealers \$23.50-28.50, high choice and prime in limited supply from \$29.00-35.00, individual head \$36. Utility and low good \$15-23.

HOGS: 1,552, week ago 1,580. Barrows and gilts around 50 cents lower than last Wednesday, sows in small supply steady. Bulk barrows and gilts U. S. mixed 2 and 3 190-240 lbs. in Wednesday's trade \$19.50-20, a few lots 1 and 2, 200-220 lbs. to \$20.50. Weights 240-270 lbs. \$18.50-19.50, some around 160 lbs. down to \$18.50. Sows U. S. mixed 1-3, 270-550 lbs. \$14-16.

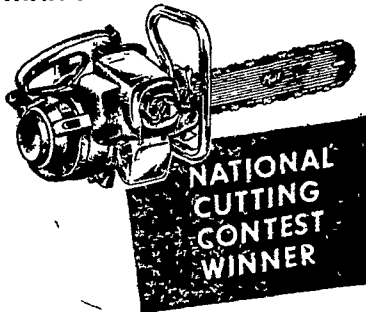
