Food Consumption Up While Calories Down

Noting that April 7 is World Health Day, Dr. Hazel K. Stiebeling, director of USDA's newly formed Institute of Home Econcmics, said the average American's diet has improved in many respects since the beginning of the century.

We eat fewer calories per person-3,220 per day as compared to 3,490 in the early 1900'sbut increased consumption of milk, meat, poultry, fish, eggs, dark green and yellow vegetables, and citrus fruit provides us with more of many elements essential to good nutrition.

Seed Prices Higher Supplies Mostly Good

The Agricultural Marketing Service reports that there are plentiful supplies of alfalfa, alsike clover, Ladino clover, ryegrass, tall fescue and most lawn grass seeds.

Seed supplies about equal to normal domestic needs include red clover, sweetclover, whit clover, lespedeza, orchardgrass redtop and Sudangrass.

In short supply, generally, are those seeds in demand for dry land areas—creasted wheatgrass. brome grass, practicall all range grasses and Timothy. Retail prices of most seeds are relatively high this year.
