Over Tillage Can Hurt Soil With Low O. M.

Millions of dollars are lost by farmers of Lancaster and other Pennsylvania counties each year through overworking the soil, declares Associate County Agent Harry Sloat. Trying to make a lettuce bed out of a corn field, he says, pulverizes the soil to such a fine state it turns to sticky mud after the first rain. Repeatedly running machinery over a field during seedbed preparation packs soil, plugs soil pores, break down desirable soil structure and prevents proper root penetration.

A finished seedbed can be prepared with minimum tillage and cost by using a rotary hoe, spring tooth harrow, spike tooth harrow, or other smoothing implements after plowing.

Allow at least two days of dry weather airing after plowing before further tillage, he advises. Failure to do this might make a
