Suffolk Sheep Hit Hardest by Scrapie

Over 97 per cent of sheep afected by Scrapie in the U. S. pelong to the Suffolk breed, acording to a report in the Journal t the American Veterinary Asociation.

A disease of the nervous system he animals seem most suscepable between the ages of 29 to 47 months, veterinary reports show.

Reported cases of this disease n the U S. rose sharply in 1952, leclined in 1953 and rose from hree infected flocks in 1954 to 22 n the early months of 1956.

The disease first appeared in he U S. in 1948. It has been conidered a virus infection. Scrapie s a slowly developing disease haracterized by progressive itchng starting in the hind quarters and progressing forward. Affected nimals also develop a peculiar ait followed by progressive paraysis and death

There is no known treatment Affected sheep must be desroyed and all related sheep kept under strict surveillance, veterinary auhorities said The United States Department of Agriculture and the agriculture departments of afrected states indemnify owners of neep which must be destroyed

Farm Cash Receipts Up 2 Per Cent In First Quarter of This Year

For the first quarter of 1957, çash receipts from farm marketing totaled about 6.4 billion dollars, up two per cent from the first three months of 1956 according to the current Farm Income Situation Report released April 24 by the Agricultural Marketing Service.

Total farm marketings are reported to be down slightly from a year ago, mostly due to smaller sales of hogs, but prices averaged four per cent higher.

Livestock receipts of 3.9 billion during the first quarter were 💻 up six per cent due to increases for cattle, hogs, and dairy products, but crop receipts, at 21/2 billion, were down slightly from last year, mostly due to smaller marketings from last year's cot-
