Suffolk Sheep Hit Hardest by Scrapie

Over 97 per cent of sheep affected by Scrapie in the U. S. belong to the Suffolk breed, according to a report in the Journal of the American Veterinary Association.

A disease of the nervous system he animals seem most susceptible between the ages of 29 to 47 months, veterinary reports show.

Reported cases of this disease in the U. S. rose sharply in 1952, declined in 1953 and rose from three infected flocks in 1954 to 22 in the early months of 1956.

The disease first appeared in the U. S. in 1948. It has been considered a virus infection. Scrapie is a slowly developing disease characterized by progressive itching starting in the hind quarters and progressing forward. Affected animals also develop a peculiar gait followed by progressive paralysis and death.

There is no known treatment. Affected sheep must be destroyed and all related sheep kept under strict surveillance, veterinary authorities said. The United States Department of Agriculture and the agriculture departments of affected states indemnify owners of sheep which must be destroyed.

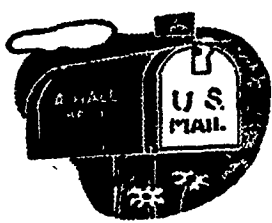

Farm Cash Receipts Up 2 Per Cent In First Quarter of This Year

For the first quarter of 1957, cash receipts from farm marketing totaled about 6.4 billion dollars, up two per cent from the first three months of 1956 according to the current Farm Income Situation Report released April 24 by the Agricultural Marketing Service.

Total farm marketings are reported to be down slightly from a year ago, mostly due to smaller sales of hogs, but prices averaged four per cent higher.

Livestock receipts of 3.9 billion during the first quarter were up six per cent due to increases for cattle, hogs, and dairy products, but crop receipts, at 2½ billion, were down slightly from last year, mostly due to smaller marketings from last year's cotton crop.
