Penn State Finds Internal Browning Caused by Tobacco Mosaic Virus

Cause of a mysterious tomato, introduced into young plants disease that has been worrying growers and processors for years has been established by a plant pathologist at the Pennsylvania State University John S Boyle, associate professor of plant pathology, found that an abnormal ripening disorder of tomato, commonly called internal browning, s caused by the tobacco mosaic vu us.
