**Armed Forces  
Increase Milk  
Consumption 65%**

Figures released in Washington last week show that the Armed Forces increased their consumption of milk by more than 309 million pints in 1956 under the special program intended to stimulate the use of more milk by troops and hospital patients. It is estimated that this supplemental program has increased consumption of fluid milk by Army, Navy, Air Force, and Marine personnel by about 65 percent over normal consumption. The figures also show that Veterans Administration hospital patients increased their consumption of milk in 1956 by about 4,200,000 pints.

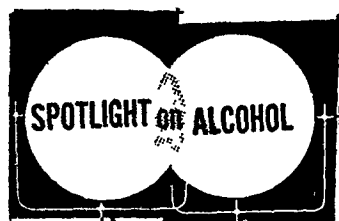
