Minnesota Declared Brucellosis Free

On June 3 acting Secretary of Agriculture True D Morse notified Gov Orville Freeman of Minnesota that his state had been declared modified certified brucellosis free This means that the disease is present in not more than one per cent of Minnesota's cattle and not more than five per cent of the herds

Minnesota is the seventh state to achieve a modified certified brucellosis free status, the other states being Delaware, Maine, New Hampshire, North Carolina, Washington and Wisconsin

In addition, 374 counties in 26 other states and in Puerto Rico have achieved this status

4-H Electric Club Tours Power Plant Dairy Cooperative in Allentown

The new PP&L electric power plant at Martin's Creek, northeast of Allentown, and the Lehigh Valley Cooperative Farmers Dairy plant at Allentown were visited Monday by about 20 members of the 4-H electric club

At Martin's Creek they saw two generating units, each capable of producing 132,500 kilowatts of power, in the new outdoor type plant

The club members were treated to a sight seldom seen by visitors to a power plant One turbogenerator was being torn down for annual overhaul and inspection, thus giving the youngsters a chance to see the intricate turbine blading and interior construction

At the dairy plant they saw a farmer owned enterprise that serves an area of 10,000 square miles in Pennsylvania and New Jersey

The plant, which employs more than 400 workers, was started in 1934 Since that time milk receipts have grown 157 times from the original 3,400 pounds of milk received the first day

farm in addition to the manufacturing activities The farm, consisting of 43 acres, has housing for 30 bulls. There are 12 Holstein, six Guernsey, five Ayrshire, three Jersey, four Brown Swiss and three Angus bulls at the farm.

Plans for the tour were made by John Riefsnyder, club leader, and by Victor Plastow, assistant county agent Transportation was provided by PP & L

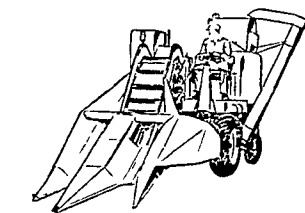
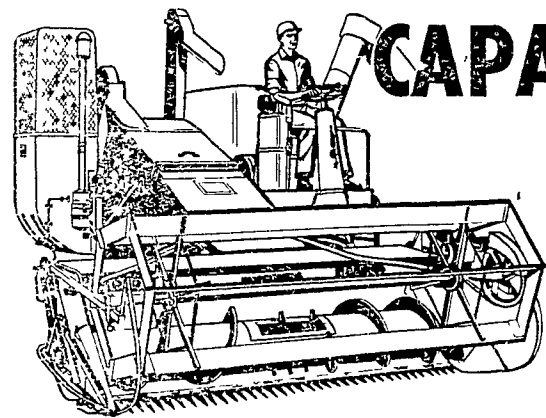

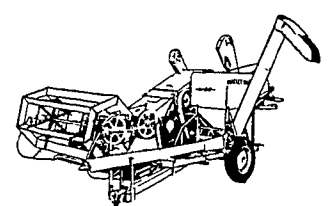
