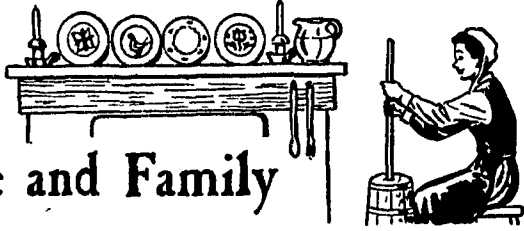

cherries
½ cup chopped toasted almonds

FUDGE BON BONS

Use chocolate, penuche or coconut quick fudge mix. Make fudge as directed on the package, omitting nuts. When fudge is cool, cut in one inch squares and roll into balls.

Decorate by rolling balls in one of the following — shredded or toasted coconut, chocolate shot, multicolored sprinkles, or colored sugar. Cherry, walnut, or pecan halves, or toasted almonds may be pressed into fudge balls for decoration.

HAWAIIAN FUDGE ROLL

Make coconut fudge using three and one-half tablespoons pineapple juice in place of water. Just before pouring, stir in one-half cup chopped walnuts and two tablespoons chopped candied cherries. When cool, shape into a roll one to two inches in diameter and 10 to 12 inches long. Wrap in wax paper and chill one-half hour. Cut in slices.

ALMOND CHERRY ROLL

Make chocolate fudge following directions on quick fudge mix package. Stir in ¾ cup chopped almonds and two tablespoons chopped candied cherries. When cool, shape into a roll one to two inches in diameter and 10 to 12 inches long. Chill one-half hour before slicing.

WALNUT FUDGE ROLLS

Make penuche fudge as directed on package. Before pouring stir in three-fourth cup chopped walnuts. When cool, shape into two rolls, about one inch in diameter and 12 inches long.

Make chocolate fudge as directed on package, except omit nuts. Pour fudge in thin layer (12x6x one-fourth inch) on wax paper. Cool slightly. Place one penuche roll on chocolate fudge. Roll like jelly roll until chocolate complet-

roll the whole family will enjoy. Other variations in making rolls are to make almond - cherry rolls or walnut fudge rolls.

Reasons Why Laying Pullets Pick

No 2 Laying pullets are in a constant state of pregnancy and since they are developing eggs daily they have cravings for various types of foods and also have quite a craving for salt. Your feed has to have just exactly the right amount of salt in it, not too much and not too little. Over-feeding on scratch grain will reduce the amount of salt. Your pullets get to the point where they will pick one another to satisfy this urge. Also feeding too high a proportion of scratch grain cuts down the protein and other vitamins they crave which frequently will get them to picking feathers and even flesh on other pullets.

Therefore, we suggest that you not feed layers more than 10 lbs of scratch grain per hundred birds per day for White Leghorns and at the very most do not feed over 12 lbs per hundred birds per day in the cold weather to heavily laying birds. Reduce scratch grain in warm weather.

Feed a top quality laying ration that is finely ground so that the birds cannot sort out coarse particles in the mash. Provides plenty of space for birds to eat and at least 3 sq ft of floor space per bird. Pullets that are overcrowded in the laying house get awfully sick of looking at one another and may start picking just on general principles. Scratch grain should be fed in the litter in all parts of the pen to provide exercise and give every bird an even chance at the feed. This allows each pullet to get enough and none to get too much.

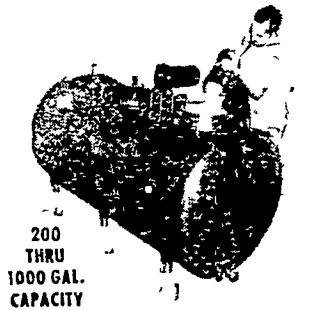

ely covers penuche roll. Press ends of fudge together to seal. Roll in chopped walnuts. Roll in wax paper and chill one-hour before slicing.

Cover remaining penuche roll with shredded coconut. Wrap in wax paper and chill one-half hour before slicing.

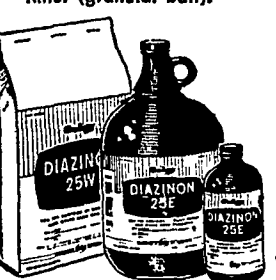
