Home Economics Congress Meets In Maryland

The American and the Canadian Home Economics Associations are hostesses for the ninth International Congress on Home Economics meeting this week, July 28 to Aug. 2, at the University of Maryland.

This is the first time a Congress has been held in North America, reports Miss Ruth K. Kimble, extension economist, Lancaster county Every four or five years since 1908, similar meetings have been held in different countries. Headquarters for the International federation are in Paris, France.

This year's attendance is estimated at one thousand, with several hundred of the delegates coming from other countries. Most of the speakers are home economists who are doing outstanding work in their own countries. Many of them are known internationally.

During the week, the North Americans will introduce the delegates from abroad to the American feature of organized discussion groups. For this Congress in the Western Hemisphere, Spanish is being added to the usual official languages of English, French, and German.

Professional field trips scheduled for three half days will include government agencies, educational institutions and commercial facilities. To further introduce the delegates from other countries to American family life, there will be informal entertainment in home for one evening.
