



Field Bromegrass Promising Cover Crop

GENEVA, N. Y. - Research at the Cornell Experiment Station here shows that field bromegrass is a promising cover crop for cherry and peach orchards. When seeded in August at the rate of eight to 10 pounds an acre, it makes sufficient growth before winter to provide a good cover crop.

Another advantage of field bromegrass, the Cornell researchers say, is that it tills extensively.
