

Farmers Bought Million Automobiles in 1955

release issued jointly Aug. by the Bureau of the Census and USDA's Agricultural Market Service estimates that farm tractor families bought 1,097, automobiles in 1955, over five-fifths of which were purchased as used cars. The figures also show that over 800,000 automobiles were sold in or sold outright by

farmers during 1955. Farmers in the Northern and Western regions traded in or sold four-fifths as many autos as they bought in 1955 and Southern farmers traded in or sold two-thirds as many as they bought that year.

convinced that a drought disaster condition exists, he will forward his recommendation to President Eisenhower. At the same time the State Disaster Committee places the request in the hands of the National USDA Disaster Committee in Washington for their consideration.

Possible relief could be designated through authorization of emergency loans to distressed farmers at three per cent interest or, if conditions are of major dis-

aster proportions, credit certificates would be issued to farmers allowing a credit of \$150 per hundred pounds toward purchase of surplus feed grains.

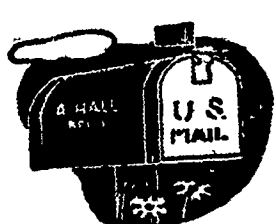
