

## Broiler Prices Down to 22.75 Cents At Lancaster Exchange Thursday

LANCASTER — Broiler prices continued to slip as the average dropped to 22.75 cents for 118,350 birds at the Lancaster Poultry Exchange Thursday.

However this is still better than a year ago when 156,025 broilers averaged 20.20 cents.

Two lots 3,500, Leghorn fowl sold at the Thursday sale for 13.4 cents and a lot of heavy fowl sold for 19 cents.

## Lancaster Markets: Feeders Weak, Fed Cattle Steady to Strong

LANCASTER — Cattle 3,742, week ago 3,932. Compared with last Wednesday, fed steers and heifers fully steady to strong, with the best action on high choice and prime. Cows around 25 cents higher, bulls about steady.

Stockers and feeders steady to weak compared with last Wednesday. The week's supply included about 35 per cent stocker and feeder steers and 12 percent cows. Around 48 loads of slaughter cattle on sale.

Bulk fed choice steers \$24.50-26.50 for weights of 1,000-1,300 lbs. One load prime 1,200 lb steers \$27.40, load prime 1,246 lbs \$27.75. Two loads mostly prime 1,055 lbs \$27.50 direct to

packers. Good and low choice fed steers \$22.75-24.25, some standard and low good \$20.50-22.50.

Small lots standard and low good heifers \$18.21-50. Bulk utility and commercial cows \$13.50-15.50, canners and cutters \$9.75-14.75, odd head strongweight cutters \$15. Utility and commercial bulls \$16.50-20, good fed yearling bulls to \$22, cutter grades \$15-16.50. Bulk medium and good stock steers and light yearlings 490-750 lbs \$19.50-21.50, common stock steers \$16.50-17.50. Numerous loads good 850-1,080 lb feeding steers \$21.50-22.75, a few around \$23.

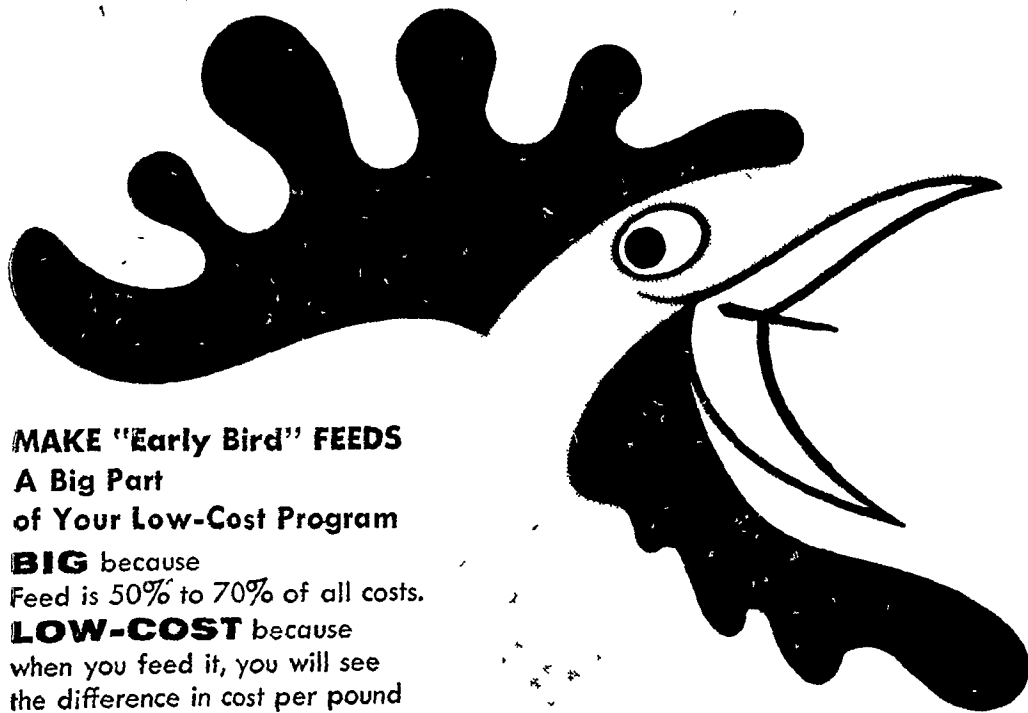

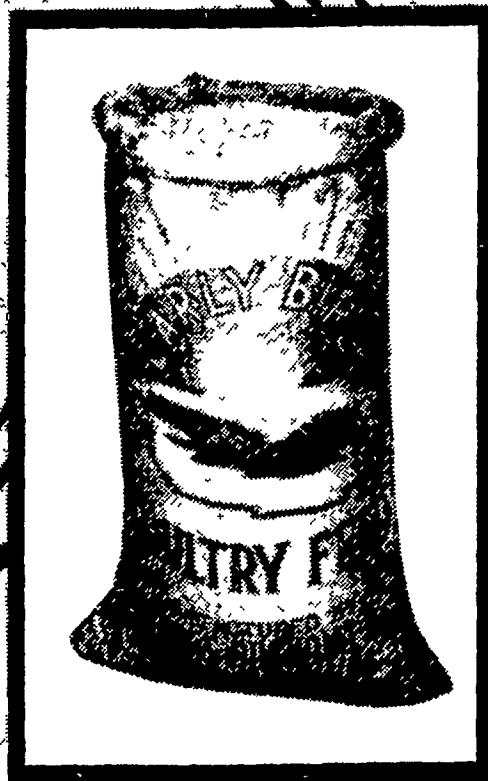

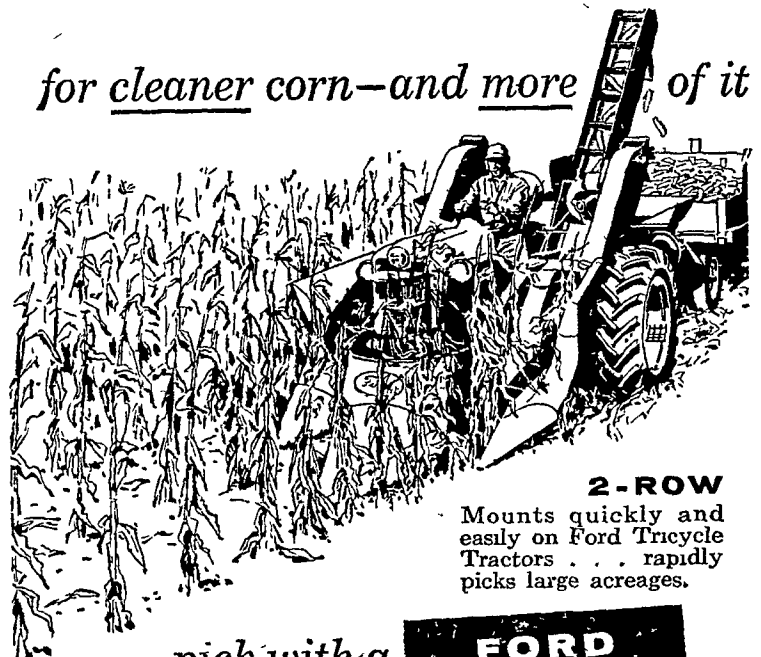
