Roselawn Farm Gets Award from Ayrshire Assn.

For distinguished success as a breeder of Ayrshire dairy cattle, Roselawn Farms of Malvern, has been presented the Constructive Breeder Award by the Ayrshire Breeders' Assn.

In order to qualify for this honor, which is considered a coveted prize in dairy cattle circles, it is necessary for the herd to excel in production and type, and in addition, a high percentage of the herd must have been bred and developed by the owner.

On a strictly twice-a-day milking schedule, the herd of 37 head made an actual production aver-

age of 9,195 pounds of milk and 394 pounds of butterfat, 97 per cent of the herd was bred or owned by this breeder for at least four years.

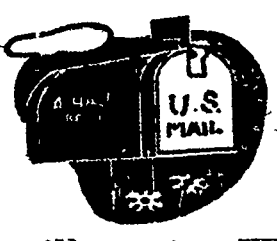
