#### REPORT ON FARM REAL ESTATE TAXES

Last week the Agricultural Research Service issued a report titled: Taxes Levied on Farm Real Estate in 1956. It shows, among other things, that taxes levied on farm real estate increased 5.3 per cent in 1956 to another record high. In relation to farm real estate values, however, the figures show that tax levies declined slightly in 1956. Although real estate taxes gained 5.3 per cent, the value of farm real estate in private ownership rose about 7.1 per cent from March 1955 to March 1956. As a result, the average tax per \$100 of real estate value fell from \$0.92 in 1955 to s0 90 in 1956.


