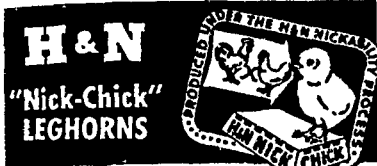


**REPORT ON FARM REAL ESTATE TAXES**

Last week the Agricultural Research Service issued a report titled: Taxes Levied on Farm Real Estate in 1956. It shows, among other things, that taxes levied on farm real estate increased 5.3 per cent in 1956 to another record high. In relation to farm real estate values, however, the figures show that tax levies declined slightly in 1956. Although real estate taxes gained 5.3 per cent, the value of farm real estate in private ownership rose about 7.1 per cent from March 1955 to March 1956. As a result, the average tax per \$100 of real estate value fell from \$0.92 in 1955 to \$0.90 in 1956.

Demand broadening for fancy large eggs and while the call is by no means active, arrivals are being absorbed in better shape with top whites up a full cent. Yesterday's sharp decline in medium whites proved too severe and with more active buying interest, prices recovered one to two cents. Medium browns are easier under a lack of fall support. Pullet whites also recovered a cent. The general position appears in better shape.

PHILADELPHIA — Sept. 18 — Unsettled. Prices advanced on top quality large and medium whites with lighter offerings readily absorbed. Other grades were in more than adequate supply for the fair demand.

Wholesale selling prices: minimum 10 per cent AA quality large 45-48 lb. white 50-53, brown 49-51, medium 49-51, medium white 38-39, brown 37-38. Extras, minimum 60 per cent A quality, large 45-50 lb. white 46-48, mixed 45-47, medium white 37-38, mixed 37-38. Standards 35-36, checks 28-29.

Prices to retailers in cartons: (cents per dozen). Grade A & U.S. grade A, large: whites 60-62, mostly 60-61; browns 59-62, mostly 59-60. Grade A & U.S. grade A, medium: whites 47-55, mostly 50-52; browns 47-55, mostly 50-52. Grade B & U.S. grade B, large: whites 52-58, mostly 54-55; browns 52-58, mostly 54-55. Receipts Sept. 17, 3,600 cases by truck.

Hens: ready-to-cook (ice packed) steady. Demand good for heavy type large and fair for light type. Adequate supplies were offered.

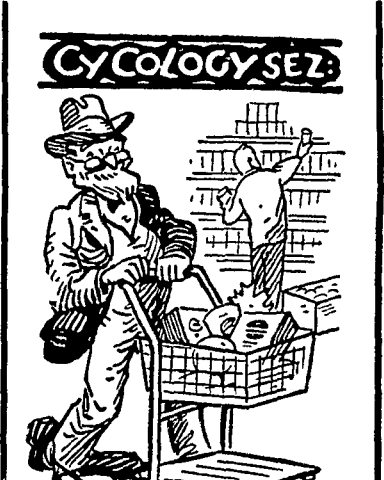
