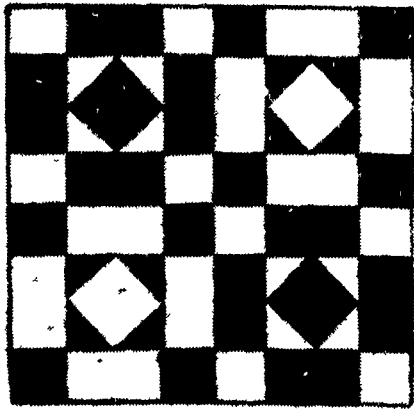

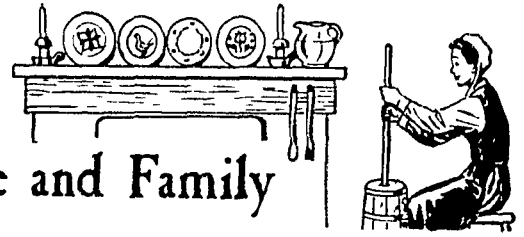

- 1 cup flaked crab meat (6½-ounce can)
 - 1 tablespoon chopped onion
 - ½ teaspoon chili powder
 - Dash salt
 - 2 teaspoons lemon juice
 - 4 English muffins, cut in halves
- Mix cheese, crab meat, onion, chili powder, salt and lemon juice. Spread crab meat mixture over English muffins. Heat under broiler until sandwich tops are golden brown. Serve hot. Makes eight open-face sandwiches (allow two per serving).

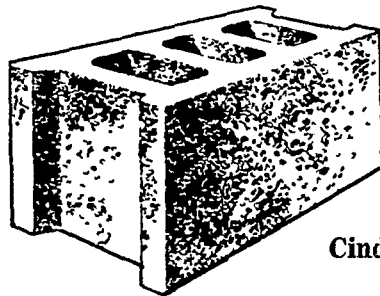
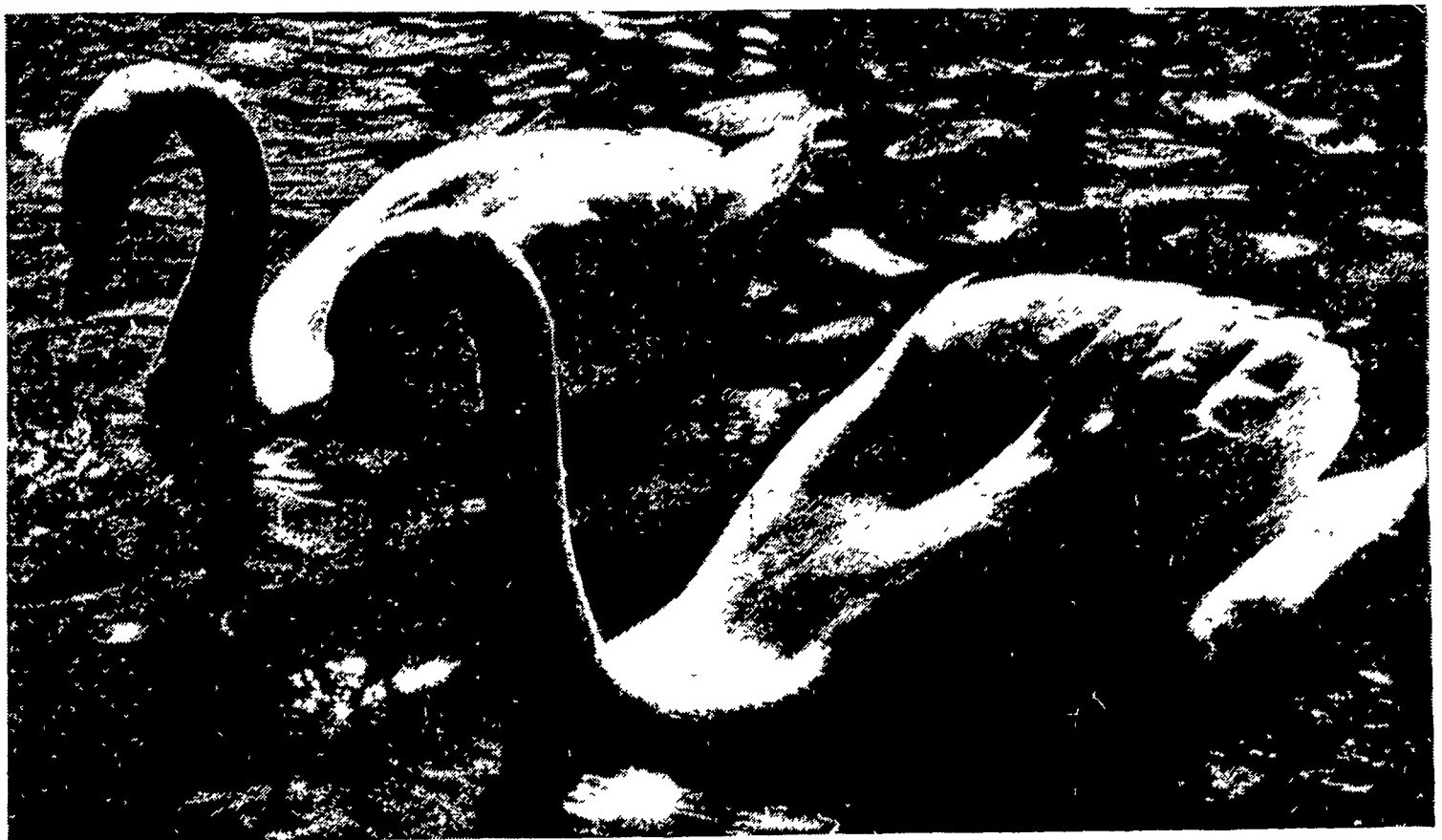
Some sandwich breads are every bit as good as their fillings. We think you'll agree that this is the case with Peanut Butter Party Rounds. These half-moon shaped sandwiches depend for a large measure of their goodness on the peanut butter bread from which they're made. Make the bread yourself, and bake it in ordinary one-pound tin cans.

PEANUT BUTTER PARTY ROUNDS

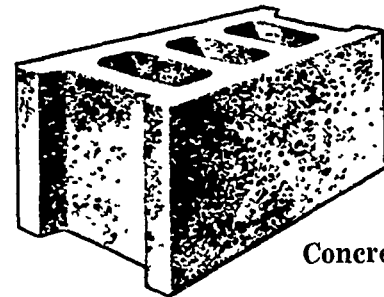
- Peanut Butter Bread**
- 1 package yeast, compressed or dry
 - ¼ cup water (lukewarm for compressed yeast, warm for dry)
 - ½ cup milk
 - ¼ cup brown sugar
 - 1 teaspoon salt
 - 2 cups sifted enriched flour (about)
 - ¼ cup crunch-style peanut butter
 - 1 egg

- Cream Cheese Spread**
- 6 ounces cream cheese, softened
 - ½ cup orange marmalade
- Soften yeast in water. Scald milk. Add sugar and salt and cool to lukewarm. Add one cup flour and peanut butter and beat until smooth. Add softened yeast and egg and mix well. Add enough more flour to make a thick batter. Beat thoroughly. Cover and
