Witney Farms Entry Largest to Date In Penna. Livestock Exposition

The largest individual entry in the first Pennsylvania National Livestock Exposition to be held Nov. 12-16, has been received by show officials from C. V. Whitney Farms of Old Westbury, N.Y., and Lexington, Ky.

Leon Falk, Jr., Pittsburgh, exposition chairman, said the Whitney entry includes 32 head of Angus that will compete with registered stock from 15 states or \$10,000 in premium money offered in the Angus class.

Falk, who is a breeder of Polled Herefords, said 2,615 head of breeding and market-type meat animals from as far west as Texas and New Mexico and from Canada to Florida will parade before judges in the Farm Show Arena in competition for a total offering of \$75,250 in premium money. Individual exhibitors total 207.

In addition to the Whitney entry, the second largest entry of cattle, 22 Angus, has been entered by Heckmere Highlands Farms, Valencia, Butler County, Pa.

One of the many features of the so-called "Keystone International" is the 36th annual National Polled Hereford Show and Sale.

Falk said. A total of \$11,000 has been offered to exhibitors from 20 states, including an entry by Franklin D. Roosevelt, Jr., son of the late President.

All of the major beef cattle, sheep and swine breeds will be exhibited at the Pennsylvania Livestock Exposition.

According to Falk, in addition to registered beef cattle, swine and sheep kept for breeding purposes, special shows for market steers, barrows and wethers, including carcass shows, will be held.

A championship wild west rodeo will take place in the Farm Show Arena during the five-day program. About 200 of the leading riders in United States will compete for points toward championship titles in five different events each evening, and during Saturday matinee. Gene Autry and Annie Oakley, western movie and television stars, will appear at each performance.

Also included in this year's livestock exposition is a special junior steer show for 4-H Club members and Future Farmers of America. Youngsters from seven states are entered in this class.

Committee Attempting to Bring Plow Matches to Hershey Estates

Deputy State Secretary of Agriculture Leland H. Bull will meet in Harrisburg on Oct. 16 with the Pennsylvania Plowing Contest committee to draft a formal invitation for the state to host the 1958 national plowing matches. Ralph E. Patterson, agricultural extension engineer at Pennsylvania State University, is chairman of the committee.

Governor George M. Leader in mid-September sent Bull to Peebles, Ohio, site of the 1957 national matches, in an effort to interest the sponsors of the annual event in considering Pennsylvania for the 1958 contest.

Bull was accompanied by James Bobb, vice president of the Hershey Estates who offered the Hershey Farms for the 1958 matches.

"The greater Harrisburg area is accustomed to handling State Farm Show and other large crowds," Bull declared. Approximately 350,000 persons attended the three-day event at Peebles.

At the 1957 contest in Ohio each of Pennsylvania's three entries placed among the first ten.

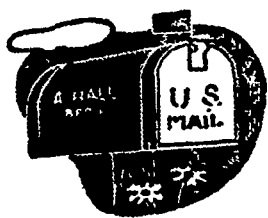
