### Spring Mill Ayrshire Completes Record

Spring Mill Pearl, a two-year old registered Ayrshire in the Spring Mill Farm of Malvern, has recently completed a record on official Heir Test of 10,309 pounds of milk and 457 pounds of butterfat made in 305 days or less, milked twice daily.

In making this announcement, Doris E. Chadburn, Acting Secretary of the National Ayrshire Breeders' Association at Brandon, Vt., advises the record is equal to over 16 quarts of milk per day for the test period.

### Arsanilic Acid Found Okay for Small Pigs

Recent research at the University of Minnesota shows that there apparently is no danger in feeding arsanilic acid to pigs in free-choice rations.

Other research at the university in past years has shown that arsanilic acid, and "antibacterial agent", has helped promote growth in pigs, but according to the Minnesota researchers, very few tests have been made as to whether the material causes any toxicity when fed in free-choice rations.

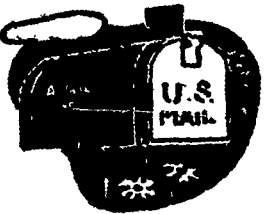
