# **Quality Standard**

A new color film illustrating United States standards for quality of poultry has been re-leased by the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

The strip consists of 53 frames and includes illustrations of the grades for stewing chickens, fryer-roaster turkeys, young hen turkeys and young tom turkeys.

The strip also may be obtained as 2x2 slides. An explanatory script accompanies each strip or set of slides.
