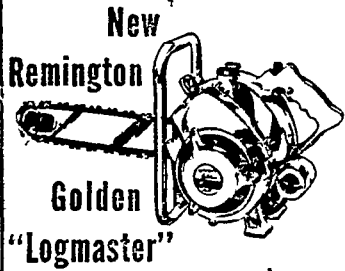

Type-wise, two of her daughters are officially classified "Very Good" — the second highest designation obtainable Another daughter is "Good Plus" — the next highest bracket
