### Food, Nutrition Group Cites Need For Research on Fats Effect on Diet

Studies to provide better knowledge of fats and their role in human nutrition were favored by the U. S. Department of Agriculture's Food and Nutrition Research Advisory Committee at its annual meeting in Washington, Nov. 4-6. The 11-member committee assigned high priority to three comprehensive proposals for extended research on dietary fats.

Established under the Research and Marketing Act of 1946, the committee is composed of outstanding food and nutrition authorities from all over the country. Its detailed recom-

mendations for food and nutrition research to be undertaken by USDA will be submitted formally to the Department within the next few weeks. Copies of this report will be available from the committee's executive secretary, Robert E. Stevenson, Office of the Administrator, Agricultural Research Service, U. S. Department of Agriculture, Washington 25, D. C.

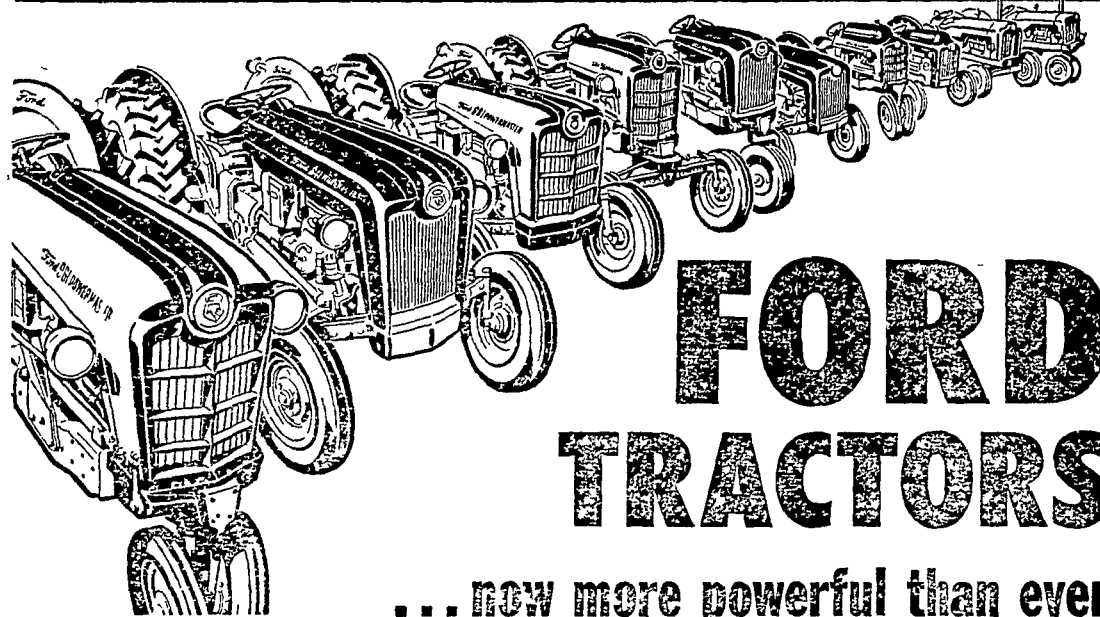

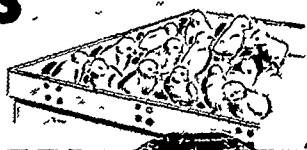
