

PSU Shows Both Winning Steer Carcasses; Fred Frey Takes Second

Pennsylvania State University, University Park, made a clean sweep on the champion and the reserve champion carcass steers on rail. Their entries, both Angus steers, won third place in the junior yearling class, and second place in the summer yearling class respectively when they were judged on foot.

Leanne Shober, 13 Berlin, Somerset County, Pa. a 4-H Club girl won the championship of the carcass lamb classes on rail, previously won reserve champion in the carcass wether classes when judged on foot.

Reserve champion of the carcass lambs, on rail classes, was

won by Sunny Crest Farm, Somerville, Ohio. This lamb, a Hampshire, previously won third place in the lamb carcass, over 100 pounds live weight class.

C. R. Galbreath and Sons, St. Md., won the championship with his Berkshire in the carcass barrow on rail classes. The barrow was judged reserve champion of the carcass barrows on foot earlier.

Oscar W. Anderson and Sons, Leland, Ill., won reserve champion in the Carcass Barrow on rail classes with his Poland China entry. His entry previously won second place when judged on foot in the Barrow Carcass class (211-

240 lbs.)

The judges were Alex McKenzie, Oklahoma A. and M. College Robert W. Bray, University of Wisconsin, and Robert Cook, Philadelphia, Pa.

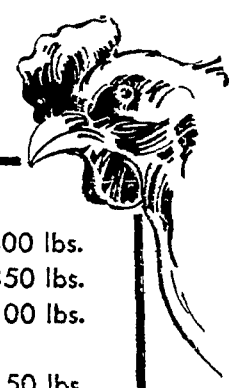
