PENB announces Major Poultry **Industry Promotions for 1958**

CHICAGO - Begining with March Egg Month, 10 intensive publicity campaigns on eggs and poultry meat stand out in the coordinated 1958 schedule of poultry industry promotions recently announced by the Poultry and Egg National Board
