Although limited by a quota system, the 4-H agricultural exhibits also were up with a total of 533. This made a total of 1,519 4-H items in the show. Allen L. Baker, 4-H leader, Penn State University, said this is the biggest 4-H list in the history of the Farm Show.

Although 15 Lancaster County Holstein breeders placed in the large show at the Farm Show, none got higher than second place.
