Residential, Small Commercial Users Get PP&L Refund

In response to queries on the Superior Court decision on \$3.8 million refund to company customers, Charles Oakes, board chairman of PP&L, said the decision was related to past rates for electric service which were in effect from Aug. 12, 1952 to Feb. 26, 1955.

Oakes explained that the company had accepted the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's order for the refunds a year ago and had been holding such funds pending the court decision. This decision was only concerned with the issue between certain industrial customers and the Commission as to what classes of customers were entitled to this refund.

Oakes said, "The refund had its sources in a 1954 court order changing previously recognized rate-making principles. At that time, the court overturned the concept that, as part of its regular costs of doing business, a utility was entitled to recover what it paid in good faith to acquire utility properties useful in serving PP&L customers."

"Instead, the court ruled, in effect, that even though properties may increase in value due to changes in the purchasing power of the dollar, this was not to be taken into account and any part of original cost was not recoverable."

Oakes said now that a decision has been made, the Company will proceed with the distribution of the refunds in accordance with the Commission requirements as soon as the necessary programming can be completed. By a decision handed down in

Philadelphia, the Superior Court has ruled that the \$3.8 million in refunds which Pennsylvania Power & Light Co. has been holding in trust for more than a year should go to the utility's residential and small commercial power customer in line with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission order of Nov. 20, 1956.

In January of last year the Court directed PP & L to invest the \$3.8 million in Government securities pending the Court's decision on what class of customers should share the refunds.

A group of P.P. & L's large industrial customers had claimed by appeal to the court that the \$3.8 million should go to them rather than to residential and small commercial power customers as ordered by the P. U. C.
