BERRY DRESSING

Mrs. Harvey K. Shoemaker,
Florin

1 cup berries

1 cup confectioners' sugar
1 egg white
Beat all at one time till thick. Serve on top of Jello. Berries should be dry, when washed let stand to drain.

Back in a November issue of Lancaster Farming a reader requested a recipe for spiced cantaloupe. Mrs. Ed Umble, Gap has sent us hers. She says in her letter

I saw the request for spiced cantaloupe. There is not much spice in this recipe but I think it is very good.

Select ripe but firm cantaloupes. Peel and cut in serving

pieces. Pack in jars. For syrup use the following:

1 cup white sugar
2 tablespoons vinegar
1 scant teaspoon salt
Dash or more of ground cloves

Enough water for one jar
Cook syrup for several minutes and pour over cantaloupes
Cook 45 minutes. Hope you like this recipe

TEEN AGE SPECIAL

1 pound ground beef
2 tablespoons lard or drippings
¼ cup chopped onion
½ cup green pepper strips,
1 can (10½ ounces) condensed mushroom soup
½ cup milk
½ teaspoon salt
4 English muffins, split and toasted
Paprika

Cook onion and green pepper in lard or drippings until tender. Add ground beef and cook until crumbly and brown but not hard. Pour off drippings. Combine soup, milk and salt and add to beef mixture. Cook until heated through, about 5 minutes. Serve on toasted English muffins. Sprinkle with paprika. Makes four servings.

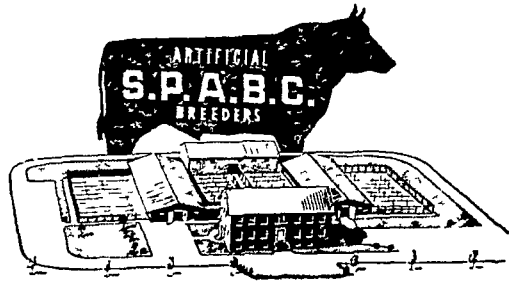
