Broilers Sell Quarter Higher; 25 1/2 Cents Top

LANCASTER — Harvey Zimmerman, R3 Ephrata, again topped the sale at the Lancaster Poultry Exchange at the Feb 20 sale by selling two lots of broilers at 25 1/4 and 25 1/2 cents.

Roy Ream paid the top of 25 1/2 cents for 2,400 birds and Carl Risser bought 700 for 25 1/4 cents. The sale average was 22 7/2 cents, about a quarter of a cent higher than last week. A total of 8,200 birds were sold, 80,850 head being broilers and the rest capettes.

The prices for capettes ranged from 28 1/2 to 26 1/2 cents. The range for broilers was from 22 to 25 1/2 cents.

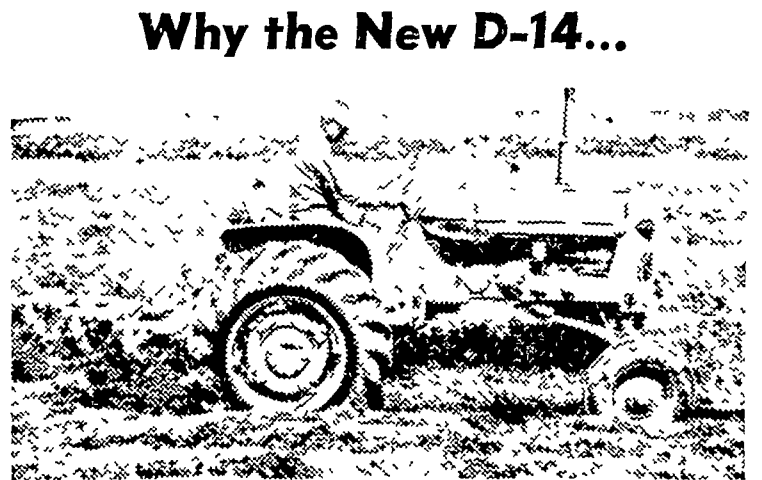
