- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup yellow or white corn meal 3 tablespoons butter or mar-
- garine

corn meal into the rice Cook over a medium heat, stirring until the milk is absorbed and the mixture thickens. Add the butter or margarine. Cool slightly Beat the egg yolks. Stir the egg yolks into the rice mixture. Beat the egg whites until stiff but not dry Fold into the rice mixture Place in a greased two-quart baking dish Bake in a pre-heated 400 degree oven about 40 minutes or until a knife inserted in the center comes out clean The top will be very brown Lower heat if top becomes too brown before mixture is done in the center. Serve immédiately with butter or margarine Hot maple or brown sugar syrup is delicious, too. This recipe makes eight servings




