Oats. Now Are **Expensive Part** Of Hog Ration

Recent research at the University of Illinois raises a question as to whether farmers can afford to fed oats to fattening hogs when oat prices are as high as corn prices

In the tests, hogs weighing about 100 pounds were fed to 200 pounds of weight on rations containing one-third oats, two-thirds oats and all oats and corn and no

Average daily gains were 175 pounds on the all-corn rations with no oats at a cost of \$9 10 per hundred pounds of gain.

When the diet contained onethird oats, gains and costs were 1 56 pounds and \$10 5, respectively; two-thirds oats, 145 pounds and \$1080, and all oats, 1.31 pounds and \$11 65.

Laid in February

A total of 4,753 million eggs were laid by farm flocks during February, a decrease of five per cent from February 1957, according to latest Crop Reporting Loard figures

The rate of lay per layer was also down a little-153 eggs in February 1958 compared to 154 in February 1957 and the 1947-56 average of 143 eggs


