

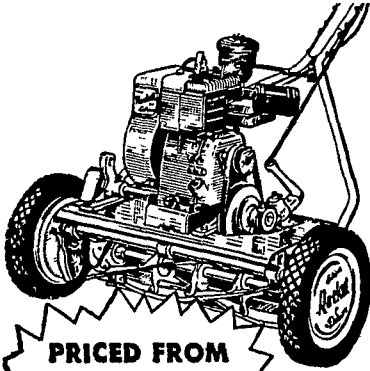

Lemon rind
1 cup boiling water
2 tablespoons lemon juice
2 teaspoons butter or margarine

Pare lemon thinly. Steep parings in boiling water. Mix corn syrup, cornstarch, and add water in which rind has been steeped. Cook on low heat until thickened. Add juice, butter or margarine.

Seems as if we're leaning towards a spicy flavor today. Here's another dessert made with molasses.

SHERMAN PUDDING

$\frac{1}{2}$ cups all-purpose enriched flour
1 teaspoon soda
 $\frac{1}{8}$ teaspoon salt
1 cup raisins
1 cup molasses
1 egg, beaten
1 cup hot water
1 tablespoon butter or margarine

Sift flour with soda and salt. Add raisins, molasses, beaten egg, then add the hot water and butter or margarine. Mix well. Pour into a well-greased mold and cover. Steam two hours. Serve with Toffee Sauce. Serves eight.

Mrs. K. Thomas Everngam, Denton, Md., Chairman of the Contest, advises that early entrants get first chance at the birds and all applications must reach her postmarked no later than May 15

THE CONTEST, WHICH is one of the main events of the 11th annual Delmarva Chicken Festival, is cosponsored by the Poultry and Egg National Board and the Delmarva Poultry Industry. It is open to non-professional cooking enthusiasts of either sex over the age of ten. Cooks from 10 to 18 (must not reach 18 before June 27) will compete on June 27, aspirants from 18 up will compete the following day. The number of contestants will be limited to 120 in the Senior Division and 100 in the Junior Division.

The Senior Champion prize is \$500 in cash, choice of a new \$500 gas or electric range, plus a trophy from the Poultry and Egg National Board. The Junior Champion will receive \$150 in cash, National Board The Junior Champion a \$250 range and a PENB trophy.

THE TOP 20 in each division will get hundreds of other prizes and every Senior entrant will receive a valuable memento.

Dishes are judged by prominent food experts on the basis of palatability, recipe clarity, and appearance. Naturally, the recipe used must feature chicken. Details can be obtained from the contest application blanks available from Mrs. Everngam, at Denton.

TOFFEE SAUCE

$\frac{3}{4}$ cup light corn syrup
 $\frac{3}{4}$ cup undiluted evaporated milk
2 tablespoons butter or margarine
1 teaspoon vanilla
Combine corn syrup, milk and butter or margarine in a saucepan. Cook on low heat, stirring constantly until butter or margarine is melted. Add vanilla. Serve warm.

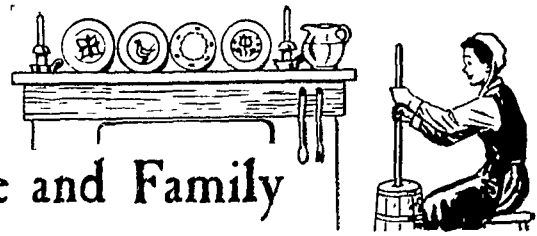

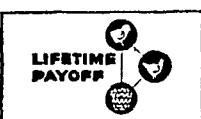
