State Vegetable **Growers** Cut **Intended** Crop

Commercial vegetable growers in the Keystone State have indicated that they intend to set 10 year average of 12,400 cres. 3,400 acres of late summer cabbage this year. This acreage, if realized, will be two per cent above the 3,300 harvested in 1957 and 21 per cent below the 1949 56 average of 4,290 acres.

The first production estimate of spring crop spinach, based on conditions to April 1, indicates a commercial crop of 30,000 hundredweight from 600 acres, the state crop reporting service says. The 1949-56 average production


of 135,000 cwt. was from an aver age of 2,400 acres. Spinach production estimates include quanti ties for processing.
